

The Swimming Facilities at
Peniel Bible Conference

are not supervised by a lifeguard or other responsible person. In place of on-site supervision, this facility has established a series of safeguards to be followed by all guests.

We are required to notify you of these rules, to ensure that water rescue equipment is at the pool or beach-side and that the swimming area is maintained in a sanitary manner. In the interest of your safety and that of your guests, we require you to follow these rules.

Please read the safety rules located at the entrance to the pool and in this brochure. If you have any questions, we will be happy to discuss them with you.

Level 3 free swim rules & regulations are as follows:

NEVER SWIM ALONE

A minimum of two adults 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use, with at least one adult on the pool deck or beachfront.

THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION

Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied to either of the aquatic facilities by a parent or guardian, or a similar adult responsible for their safety and behavior.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, NOTIFY THE FACILITY OPERATOR AND CONTACT HELP IMMEDIATELY

A free telephone is provided at this facility. Telephone numbers for the nearest emergency medical service are posted.

POOL RULES

ONLY use this facility during posted hours of operation
NO glass containers in pool area
NO food or drink in the pool area, except for plastic water bottles.
NO hanging on the buoy lines.
NO running on deck
NO diving
NO jumping in the shallow
NO floatation devices allowed
NO horseplay
NO holding breathe contests (hypoxia)
In the event of thunder or lightning **ALL** swimmers **MUST** leave the water immediately for a minimum of **30 minutes**. Swimmers may return if there is no other signs of thunder or lightning within the **30 minutes**.

Injuries can be prevented and safety is everyone's responsibility. If you notice any problems with the water quality or the absence of safety equipment, please notify us at once.

ANY ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES AT THE POOL MUST BE REPORTED TO THE OFFICE IMMEDIATELY.
