A little note about Registration & Dismissal

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are so excited about this year's Snofun! The Staff has been planning and praying for months that this event will be meaningful and FUN!

Peniel is located at 336 Lake Tour Road, Lake Luzerne NY. The easiest route from I-87, north or south, is exit 21. At ramp-end, turn on State Route 9N south toward Lake Luzerne for 9.4 miles. Turn left on Read Park Road for .6 mile. Bear right at the fork to Lake Tour Road. The winter entrance to Peniel Bible Conference is about 150 feet on the left.

Registration is at 2:30 pm, first day of event.

Park in the winter parking area (in front of the lodge) and bring all packed belongings, forms, medicines, and event balance money into the Lamplighter Restaurant, at the right of the parking lot entrance. This will help to cut down on pedestrian traffic in the parking lot during potential wintry conditions. The registration table will be set up in the dining room, where we'll complete the process.
