GENERAL SAFETY RULES

POOL RULES

- ONLY use this facility during posted hours of operation
- NO glass containers in pool area
- NO food or drink in the pool area, except for plastic water bottles.
- NO hanging on the buoy lines.
- NO running on deck
- NO diving
- NO jumping in the shallow
- NO floatation devices allowed
- NO horseplay
- NO holding breathe contests (hypoxia)

THUNDER AND LIGHTNING

In the event of thunder or lightning

- ALL swimmers MUST leave the water immediately for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- Swimmers may return if there is no other signs of thunder or lightning within the **30 minutes**.

► NEVER SWIM ALONE: A

minimum of two adults, 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use, with at least one adult on the pool deck or beachfront.

 THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE

SUPERVISION: Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied to either of the aquatic facilities by a parent or guardian, or a similar adult responsible for their safety and behavior.

 IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, NOTIFY THE FACILITY OPERATOR AND CONTACT HELP IMMEDIATELY: A free telephone is provided at this facility. Telephone numbers for the nearest emergency medical service are posted.

 ANY ACCIDENTS OR INJURIES AT THE POOL MUST BE REPORTED TO THE OFFICE IMMEDIATELY:

Injuries can be prevented and safety is everyone's responsibility. If you notice any problems with the water quality or the absence of safety equipment, please notify us at once.
